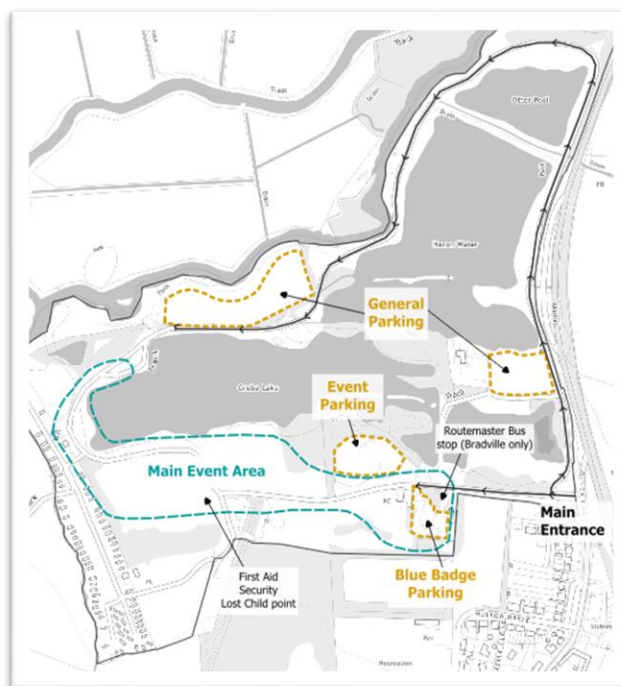

**Car:** General parking costs £5.50 per vehicle – you can pay on entry at the machine using credit/debit card or coins (no change given). Apple Pay and Google Pay are accepted. Blue Badge parking is free.
